#### A. INTRODUCTION

In literature, the components of beauty can be seen from the aesthetics of the language, the choice of characters, the problems that flow within it, the philosophy of the story, etc. It is in literature that the author expresses his feelings. Other aspects of such as sociology, culture, anthropology etc (Kurniati et al., 2023). Psychology is also included in this aspect. Character analysis is carried out using psychology, psychology is the science of the mental and behavior of characters (Budiman n.d.). A novel is a literary work that makes the character the most important role, where every characterization presented by the character will be the carrier of the plot (Kurniati et al., 2024). every characterization carried by the character has an effect on the story. Djasi (2000) said that characterization is the identification of the physical and mental characteristics of a character. Characterization can be described directly or indirectly. Directly the characterization is explained by the author or called explicit, indirectly the characterization is described through the character's characteristics which are known through dialogue, behavior, or the results of the character's thoughts.(Annisa, Patmarinanta & Potjut 2000).

Apart from that, the characterization of each character can also cause effects, reactions and emotions in each reader. This novel is a literary work that uses literary psychological studies. Sigmund Freud, a pivotal figure in the field of Western psychology, was born on May 6, 1856, in Freiberg to a Jewish family of German descent. As Adolf Hitler came to power, Freud sought refuge in England, where he ultimately passed away in London on September 23, 1939(Hamali 2018). In psychoanalytic theory, Freud in 1923 divided the formation of human personality into 3 types, ego, super ego and id.(Nursafira et al. 2019). The theory of psychoanalysis, developed by Sigmund Freud, provides important insights in understanding the deepest aspects of human behavior, both in real life and in literary works. The human mind, according to Freud, is structured like an iceberg, where most mental processes are outside our awareness, influencing our behavior indirectly.

In a literary context, a psychoanalytic approach can help us understand characters and motifs in literary works. This kind of analysis not only enriches our understanding of the text, but also provides deeper insight into the inner conflicts experienced by individuals, whether in personal or cultural contexts. However, although this psychoanalytic approach is valuable, it should not be used as the only way to understand literary works. A work of art has a broader dimension, encompassing aesthetic experiences and symbolic meanings that go beyond mere psychological interpretation. Therefore, although psychoanalytic literary criticism provides a useful tool for exploring deeper meaning in literature, it is still important to consider various other perspectives in the analysis of literary works and human life as a whole.(Kuleshova n.d.)

Dustin Thao is a Vietnamese American writer based in southern California. from the title of the novel you have reached Sam is a girl who tries to let go of her lover. This novel carries the theme of a tragic love story which has an impact on human personality and mentality.

Even though Sam is just a mirage, Julie still considers him real and will continue to make his dreams come true. until one day, Julie felt like she had failed. At that moment Sam felt he had to leave Julie. However, Sam asked Julie to move on with her life. Until finally Juli graduated from graduation, that was the day when Juli seemed to be born again, she became willing to socialize with her mother, family and friends. Apart from Juli, Mika's mental condition as Juli's friend and Sam's family has also improved, she has accepted Sam's departure and her interactions with Juli have improved.
