Introduction

Many challenges must be faced until finally one by one of them died horribly because of their own sister. Researcher is interested in analyzing the characterization of the character in this film, played by Noomi Rapace, who plays seven different characters so that researcher conducts this research related to characterization under the title An Analysis of Seven Characters played by Noomi Rapace in the "What happened to Monday?" film.

Research Method

By using qualitative study, researcher obtains data in the form of qualitative data. Sugiyono (2011:7) explains that qualitative research is called postpositive research because it is based on the philosophy of post-positivism. This research is also called artistic research because the research process is more artistic (less patterned), and is referred to as interpretive research because the research data is more concerned with the interpretation of the data found in the field.

The method used in this research is descriptive analytical method. The analytical descriptive method according to Sugiyono (2009:29) is a method that functions to describe or provide an overview of the object under study through data or samples that have been collected as they are without analyzing and making general conclusions.

In other words, analytical descriptive research takes problems or focuses attention on problems as they were when the research was carried out, and the results of the research which are then processed and analyzed will draw conclusions. For the analysis of seven characters played by Noomi Rapace in the –What happened to Monday? film and its moral messages, the researcher will use this method because it is suitable for achieving the objectives of this research.

The data in this study is the main part provided in the research principle and the goal is to solve the problems. The researcher has chosen the "What Happened to Monday?" film as the data source. Meanwhile, the data for this research are the scenes and dialogues of the main character, Noomi Rapace, playing 7 different characters in the film to find the characterization of the character played by her and the scenes and dialogue of some characters related to the main character to find the moral messages. This film is directed by Tommy Wirkola and written by Max Botkin and Kerry Williamson.

The method of collecting data is documentary technique that proposed by Ary, et al, (2002). It is about collecting data by observing an event or setting: or documents of popular culture, such as books, films, and videos. In addition to that, technique in collecting data allows the writer to thoroughly collect the object of the study. Therefore, since the researcher uses analytical descriptive method for this study, the researcher requires available data that were taken from a film which suited to the method.

The research data are in the form of scene footage and dialogue from the main character, Noomi Rapace, from the film. They were collected based on the study objectives. In short, researcher must carefully select the data needed in the film –What Happened to Mondayl.

Referring to the method used to complete the analysis according to Ary, et al, (2002), the researcher uses several steps to collect the research data of how Noomi Rapace played 7 different characters and the moral messages in this film. Those are:

- 2. Identifying all the scenes played by Noomi Rapace and the dialogue in the film to get the data
- 3. Collecting the data that addresses the problem to be studied
- 4. Analyzing the data that has been collected and make conclusions due to research

The researcher needs to explain the techniques used to verify data. Generally in qualitative research, it is used to check data validity, credibility, transferability, dependability, and confirmability.

The researcher chooses credibility as data validity checking in the form of increasing persistence. According to Sugiyono (2011), increasing persistence in testing the validity of data means making observations more carefully and continuously. In this way, data certainty will be recorded with certainty and systematic.

In this study, to determine the characterization of the main character, Noomi Rapace, that played 7 different characters and the moral messages in this film, the researcher will watch the scenes played by her and the dialogue repeatedly to find the characterization of the main character, and watch the scenes played by some characters related to the main character and the dialogue repeatedly to find the moral messages in it. This activity assures the reader that the data obtained can be trusted.

Technically, content analysis includes classifying the symbols used in communication, using criteria and classification, using certain analytical

techniques in making predictions. Content Analysis is often used for verification analyzes.




Chart 3.1: Analysis of qualitative research data

Findings and Discussion

This presents the findings of the study referring to the proposed research problems, covering to the seven characterizations that played by Noomi Rapace and the moral messages of the -What happened to Mondayl film. This research had been conducted for two months since 17 May 2021 to 3 July 2021.

1) Characters

Related to the study of the film, the researcher only takes the main characters that were played by Noomi Rapace. Noomi Rapace played -Karen Settmanl as the cover identity of *Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday,* the seven twin sisters who share one public face, the stoic, uber- professional, and successful career woman. Every day they switch the role as Karen Settman to trick the government officials. Because the setting of the film shows that only one child who can live in the world, they must survive to live together in the situation. They will go out on the day according to their name and share any experience they have on that day.

In the film, there are seven characters played by Noomi Rapace. Those are:

1. Monday (Monday is controlled and always stuck to the rules, cold, ambitious and tough, perfectionist and is always done what is expected, a stasher, and a girl with altruism).



2. Tuesday (Tuesday is a pot-smoking. She smokes a lot of weed to calm herself down, easy going, soft and sensitive, and a caring girl).



3. Wednesday (Wednesday is an athletic who loves training, tomboyish, tough, confident, and confrontational girl).




4. Thursday (Thursday is a rebel, yearns for freedom, and a caring girl).

2) Moral Message

The existence of seven identical twins surviving in that era was very stressful. Their struggle for 30 years to hide their true identity by wearing the mask "Karen Settman", their mother's name can be imitated. Each of these seven characters has their own role in keeping their identities from being revealed, like Friday who became the brain of their success so far, Thursday who became the leader in the family, and Sunday with her motherly nature who always cared about the others. Various ways to survive is not an easy thing to do, so do what we can for a better life.
- Of course, the seven characters played by Noomi Rapace are different, especially when it comes to self-confidence. One of them has no self-confidence, Friday, but she can make up for her shortcoming with her genius in technology, mathematics and science. Everyone certainly has strengths and weaknesses. It would be better if we can cover our weaknesses with the strengths we have.
- The fear of endangering their lives did not escape the character played by Noomi Rapace. They are afraid of being caught by the Bureau, but that fear never seems to arise when they gather together. When we have something

that is feared by ourselves, with someone we care about, we can definitely overcome that fear.

- Death certainly haunts everyone. It never occurred to them that that day would come so quickly. Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday died because their existence had been opposed by the Bureau from the start, but they could be hidden by their grandfather and could last for 30 years. This incident allowed Tuesday and Thursday.
- to continue living with the belief that their siblings can rest well because after their death, the world returns to normal with no limit on how many children one family should have. Excessive sadness because of being left behind will have a bad impact on us. Believe that life will continue thanks to those who have gone before us.

In the previous points, the researcher has discovered and analyzed some data about the character of the main character in the film and moral messages being discussed. In this point, the researcher describes more deeply about the character of the main character.

The researcher has found the seven characters played by Noomi Rapace as Monday from watching the film that she is perfectionist, tough, controlled, and ambitious. She has to cope with the worst day of the week—Monday. She most truly represents the character of Karen Settman. The difference between her and her sisters is that she's always stuck to the rules and she's always done what is expected. For many years she has sacrificed herself. When she meets someone and falls in love, a storm happens inside and she starts to question everything she has learned and the rules she grew up with. She might seem cold but under that she has a big heart and she is a girl dreaming of love and following her own dreams.

Tuesday is a pot-smoking. She is very sensitive and smokes a lot of weed to calm herself down. She cares about her sisters. She is a happy soul who is soft and sensitive. She is also a joke lover. She wears big skirts and lots of jewelry. She will feel happy if she can live out in the world.

Wednesday is an athletic, tomboyish, tough, confident, and confrontational girl and a trained fighter. She loves training and is into martial arts. She's always boxing, training and working out. The other sisters keep telling her she can't work out too much because she is getting too big and they all need to be the same silhouette to protect their cover. She is practical—a real fighter who puts her fears aside. Wednesday is like a little pit bull.

Thursday is a rebel. She is yearns for freedom but she loves her sisters and becomes the leader. She is wild at heart and feels trapped in the situation she lives in. When she was growing up, she was always breaking the rules and was the opposite of Monday.
